Applicants must possess at least one of the following: Associate Degree **or** 64 or more semester hours (90 or more quarter hours) of matriculation toward a Bachelors Degree from an accredited college/university **or** Current Peace Officer Professional Standards (POPS) Certification in Kentucky, with no disciplinary action(s) within the last year of employment **and**, meet all applicable requirements for a police officer per POPS. If a current Police Officer in another state, must meet POPS standard (KRS 15.380-15.402) **or** Current or former Police Officer from another state who has served a minimum of one (1) year as a full time sworn Law Enforcement Officer, **or** have obtained Military Occupational Specialty of Army or Marine Military Police, Air Force Security Service or Navy Master At Arms.

Applicants must be: 21 years of age; a U.S. citizen, free from felony conviction, willing to work irregular hours and days, of good health, free from alcohol and drug dependency. The KCAB Police Officers need not be a Kentucky resident, but will be required to live within a reasonable geographic boundary that the Board believes is safe for the operation of the Airport. The Board has determined the following counties to be within a reasonable response time to the Airport premises: Boone, Kenton, Campbell, Pendleton, Grant, Owen, Gallatin, Carroll, Hamilton, Butler, Warren, Clermont, Franklin, Ripley, Switzerland, Ohio, and Dearborn Counties.
